## Fish and Chip Run to Dunwich Beach

A slight change of plan for the run today. Unfortunately Mike is unable to attend, hence I've been drafted in to organise the run at the last minute. Having only got the news on Thursday I'm afraid I haven't had time to do a tulip route. Instead you are left with a SatNav postcode route with directions. There are two stops and a drive through Lowestoft. I haven't had time to drive it, so I'll just wish you good luck and I'll hopefully see you at Dunwich Beach. Enjoy;—)

Starting from The Gull Inn, Framingham Pigot, NR14 7PL

We are aiming to meet at Dunwich Beach car park at 1pm. Journey time is approximately 1 3/4 hours. We've allowed 45 minutes coffee break stop at the Urban Jungle and 15 minutes to walk around Southwold. Obviously you can spend the time however you wish.

Note the postcodes might take you past or stop before the destination so I suggest you use the directions too. NR32 2PN (Lowestoft Cemetery) and NR32 1PE (Police Station) postcodes are for direction only, stay on the main roads when reaching these and update your SatNav to the next postcode.

First stop Coffee break - Urban Jungle Plant Nursery and Coffee Shop, London Road, Weston, Beccles, Suffolk

Using SatNav: NR34 8TT

*Directions:* Take the A146 East toward Beccles. Turn right at the Beccles roundabout onto A145 and follow the one way system through the centre of Beccles and carry on to Urban Jungle Garden Centre for a coffee break.

## A drive through Lowestoft

Using SatNav: NR32 2PN (Lowestoft Cemetery). Do not stop here, stay on the A1144 but reset your SatNav to NR32 1PE (Police Station). Again do not stop here, but stay on the A47 and change SatNav to IP18 6NB

*Directions:* On leaving the garden centre take the B1127 at the roundabout towards Lowestoft. Turn right onto A146 towards Lowestoft. Keep straight heading through Oulton Broad and into the centre of Lowestoft on the A1144. Go past Lowestoft Cemetery on your right (NR32 2PN).

Turn right onto the A47 and past the Police Station (NR32 1PE) on your left. The A47 goes into the A12 over the bridge. Keep on the A12.

Second stop - Southwold beach and harbour

Using SatNav: IP18 6NB

Follow the A12 to Wrentham and turn left onto the B1127 to Southwold. At Blackwater turn left onto A1095. Follow this to the second stop, Harbour Quay Car Park, Ferry Road (IP18 6NB). From here you can park and walk to the Alfred Corry Lifeboat Museum, beach and harbour.

Final destination - Dunwich Beach Car Park

*Using SatNav:* **IP17 3EN** (Dunwich Beach Car Park). Ignore the SatNav and turn left out of the carpark to continue in the direction you were travelling.

*Directions:* Turn left on leaving the car park (or drive past if not stopping) and drive along the River Blyth. Go past York Road car park and turn left back on to the A1095.

Turn left at the junction onto the A12 for a short distance before turning left just after the White Hart PH onto Angel Lane, B1125, at fiveways junction follow signpost towards Dunwich Beach (IP17 3EN).
